Kidannie Laboy was born in Puerto Rico. As a teenager the Lord saved Kidannie. He is married to Sara Puerto, who is originally from Honduras. He is a member of Iglesia Bautista Palabra de Vida in Tampa where he serves in preaching, teaching, discipleship, leadership, and various other ways. God has called Kidannie to the ministry of church planting.

In August 2021 Kidannie and his wife Sara moved from Spring Hill to Miami to be part of the NAMB Residency program through SEND Network, accredited by Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and under the guidance and supervision of the pastors of Providence Road Church.

Before launching the new church plant in Spring Hill, Kidannie and Sara will return to their local church in Tampa to be sent out, along with a church planting core team.




Why Spring Hill?


The city of Spring Hill is located 40 miles north of the city of Tampa. With 113,568 residents, Spring Hill is the largest community in Hernando County. It has an approximate Hispanic community of 21,577 people (2020 Census), representing 19% of the total population. Currently, it is one of the most sought after areas outside of Tampa, mainly because of its competitive real estate prices. According to the latest statistics on faith and religion, 73% of people do not identify with any religion, 10% identify as Catholic, 5% identify with other religions, and only 12% of people identify as Evangelical Protestant. This means 88% of the population needs to hear the good news of salvation.

Port Richey, New Port Richey, Brooksville, and Hudson are all nearby communities and not far from Spring Hill. These areas have had significant economic growth and share, with our target city, a great need for healthy local churches where the Gospel is preached.

Our mission is to bring glory to God by making disciples through the public and personal teaching of the Word, as well as community life and service to one another, all centered on the Gospel.

Gospel-centered

We have all rebelled against our Creator and Judge, but He in His grace, sent His Son to die for our sin, and credits the righteousness of Christ to those who repent of their sin and believe in the death and resurrection of Jesus. Expository Preaching

Since the Word of God is our absolute standard of doctrine, teaching and practice, we are committed to expositing it in every area of ministry (Neh. 8:8, 2 Tim. 2:15; 3:16-17).

Evangelize

We are committed to proclaiming the good news of salvation to the lost through evangelism. Our task is to present the Gospel clearly and explicitly, leaving the act of conversion to God (Matt. 28:19–20; Acts 1:8).

Discipleship

Promoting Discipleship

We are committed to discipleship. We want to be intentional in the spiritual growth and maturity of our church members, each member committed to discipling others so that a culture of oneanother ministry is cultivated (Col. 1:28, Acts 11:23-26).

Developing Elders

We are committed to equipping faithful men whom God calls to pastoral ministry. We will seek to prepare these men through an intentional discipleship program and practical ministry opportunities. To help each person develop a philosophy of ministry, gain practical wisdom, love for the church, and experience in preaching, teaching, discipling, counseling, and service (2 Tim. 2:2, Titus 1:5).

Our vision is to be a multigenerational, bilingual church. We are a family redeemed by Christ (Eph. 2:19–22). We will meet regularly to exalt Christ, hear preaching, exhort, edify and encourage one another. Watching over one another's needs and serving one another in love (Acts 2:45, Rom. 12:13, 1 Cor. 12:25, Gal. 6:10).

Our vision is to be a sending church like the church at Antioch (Acts 13:2). To train and send planters to new places, to support local and international missions, and to help pastors, missionaries, and planters advance the kingdom of God.





- Continue cultivating relationships with non-believers
- Complete training for pastors
- Install 2 pastors
- Send planter to church planting residency program
- Identify deacons
- Become a self-sustaining church

- Continue to cultivate relationships with non-believers
- Continue to reproduce leaders
- Establish 4 deacons
- Begin supporting foster parents
- Plant a new church


